Buddy Recipes

Pumpkin Bites submitted by Linda Knilans

- 2 cups and 3 tablespoons of flour, 1 cup of uncooked oatmeal, ½ cup of canned pumpkin, ½ cup water, 2 tablespoons canola oil or olive oil, ½ teaspoon of nutmeg, ½ teaspoon of ground cinnamon, ½ cup chopped carrots
- Preheat oven to 375F. Combine pumpkin, water, oil, cinnamon and nutmeg in a bowl. Mix well. Stir in the carrots, then the oatmeal and gradually mix in the flour. Make a ball and roll out on counter top or baking pas. Cut into desired shapes with a cookie cutter. Bake 30-35 minutes on an ungreased cookie sheet until they start to turn brown on edges. Store in an airtight container in the refrigerator.
