Did You Know Tulips Are Toxic To Pets?

Dr. Elizabeth Ashbaugh from Wheatridge animal hospital gave a Canine First Aid presentation at Jefferson County fairgrounds at our meeting on Sunday April 27th. She talked about plant, food and house hold item toxins, demonstrated how to bandage a wound on Gangway Will He Eclipse, and discussed what to do about heat stroke, seizures, vomiting and diarrhea. Members and guests got to ask questions about choking, creating a first aid kit and even rattle snake bites.

According to Elizabeth every dog owner should have the following items in their first aid kit:

1. Phone numbers to local veterinary emergency hospitals and your veterinary hospital
2. Clean towels & blanket
3. Bandaging material (gauze, first aid tape, bandage rolls), newspaper or splint material
4. Cleaners: saline or bottled water, hydrogen peroxide
5. Medicines: triple antibiotic ointment, Benadryl
6. Nutrients: high sugar source (such as Karo syrup), re-hydration solution (such as pedialyte)
7. Lubricant such as KY Jelly
8. Disposable gloves

Above all she stated to always "Use caution!" when dealing with an injured animal. "Even the nicest dogs can be aggressive when in pain."

Buddy Recipes

What is your favorite recipe?

"Milk Bone" Dog Biscuits

- 3/4 cup hot water
- 1/3 cup margarine
- 1/2 cup powdered milk
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 egg, beaten
- 3 cups whole wheat flour
- Variation: increase margarine to 1/2 cup and add 2 teaspoons sugar

In large bowl pour hot water over the margarine. Stir in powdered milk, salt, and egg. Add flour, 1/2 cup at a time. Knead for a few minutes to form stiff dough. Pat or roll to 1/2 inch thickness. Cut into bone shapes. Bake at 325 degrees for 50 minutes. Cool. They will dry out quite hard. Makes about 1 1/4 pounds of biscuits. Costs around 30 cents per pound.
