## Buddy Recipes

### What is your favorite recipe?

#### Sweet Molasses Treats

- 2 1/2 c Flour, whole wheat is nice
- 1/2 c Powdered milk
- 1 tb Molasses
- 6 tb Meat drippings or margarine
- 1 Egg, beaten
- 1/2 c cold water

Preheat oven to 350. Lightly oil a cookie sheet. Combine flour, powdered milk, salt, garlic powder and sugar. Cut in meat drippings until mixture resembles corn meal. Mix in egg. Add enough water so that mixture forms a ball. Using your fingers, pat out dough onto cookie sheet to half inch thick. With a pizza wheel cutter score the dough into the desirable sizes. Bake 25 to 30 minutes. Remove from tray and cool on rack. Break apart and they are ready to go.
