## Colorado Legislature

House Bill 09-1172 was introduced to the Colorado Legislature on January 21<sup>st</sup>. The bills supporters are State Representatives McCann and Fischer. The bill is also supported by The Humane Society of the United States and The American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals. It is being represented as a measure to take on Puppy Mills.

"I am pleased to introduce legislation that seeks to ensure that dogs that are kept for breeding in Colorado are treated in a safe and humane manner," said Rep. McCann from the steps of the state's capitol building.

The bill limits the number of unsterilized dogs over 6 months of age that a dog breeder may keep on premises licensed under the "Pet Animal Care and Facilities Act". Mandates annual certification by a licensed veterinarian that a dog is suitably healthy for breeding before the dog may be bred. It authorizes the commissioner of agriculture to adopt reasonable rules to enforce this article.

The Colorado Federation of Dog Clubs opposes the bill stating on their website (<http://www.codogfederation.org/news.html>), that the bill "would severely restrict the number of intact dogs any breeder could own. The position of the Federation is that the bill is not only unnecessary but overly restrictive in its proposed changes." As of Jan 15<sup>th</sup> their site says "This will be the biggest issue of the year so we will need everyone's support and involvement. We have been actively working on this issue since the end of December and will post a position statement for member clubs this coming week." As of this writing I could not find a post of their position statement.

If passed this bill will go into effect on Jan 1 2011.

## Buddy Recipes

What is your favorite recipe?

### Liver Snacks

- 2 lbs chicken livers
- 2 C corn meal
- 2 C wheat germ
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 C dried parsley

Liquefy livers in food processor, pour into mixing bowl and add other ingredients. Mix until smooth like a brownie batter. Spread on a cookie sheet (1/2 sheet cake size) (I use parchment paper to line the pan) until it's evenly spread about 1/3 inch thick. Bake at 350 F for about 35 minutes. When cool cut into squares, or whatever shapes you prefer. I keep them in a zip-lock bag in the refrigerator.
