CSMSC is #1!

Thanks to the efforts and dedication of breeding club members like Carole Alex, Kathy Dodge and Linda Wahlquist-Soos CSMSC out ranked any other club in the Nation for total number of dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Health Information Center (CHIC) program. In fact over half the dogs enrolled are from Colorado!

The CHIC program, sponsored by the AKC Canine Health Foundation, houses the premier centralized database designed for breed clubs to use to collect important health information about their respective breeds. To be apart of the CHIC program a dog has to have it's CERF exam, (eye test) and Cardiac auscultation (exams by stethoscope) with Myotonia testing being an optional test. The required tests have been selected under the specific advice of veterinarians and members of the AMSC. AMSC members who choose to participate through testing and authorizing disclosure of test results will have their dogs recognized by receiving a CHIC number for each individual dog tested.

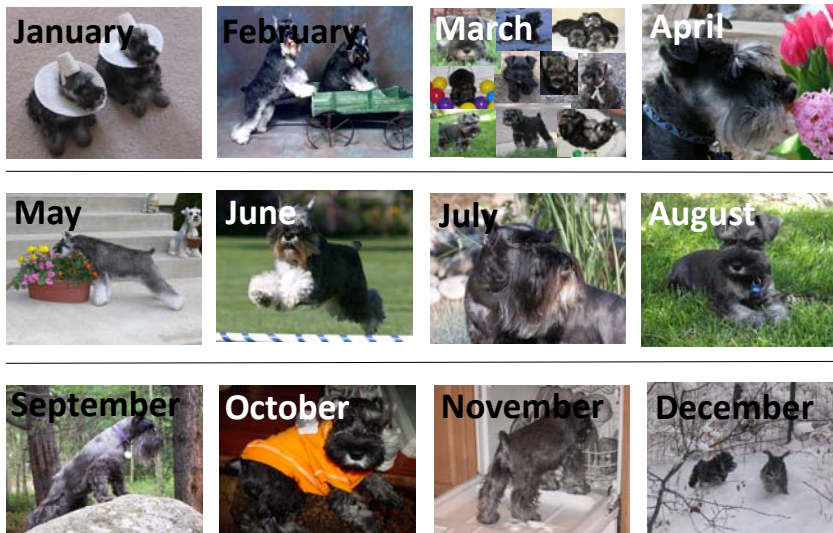
