I would highly recommend showing in Canada. The conformation people were wonderful in general, and Connie Krohn was amazing. She helped me so much with grooming and her partner Trina coached me daily in showing. Another handler, Doug, who didn't know us at all, helped with the underlines on both dogs. (Connie helped groom her biggest competition in the second show – the camaraderie was amazing. No one seemed threatened by anyone else – it didn't seem like winning was everything.

We finished both boys in 3 shows – the first at Kenora, in Northwestern Ontario, (a beautiful show site), the second in Saulte Ste Marie, on Lake Superior, and the third (the Nationals) in Woodstock, in Southern Ontario. There weren't many points in schnauzers at the first to shows (a few 2 point shows and several 1 point shows. TJ finished the last day of the second show with a 2 point win. Sonny beat TJ twice and came away from the second show with 3 points. (He only showed once at the first show – and surprised us by beating TJ and the girls for BOW (2 points).

At the nationals there were 26 schnauzers entered. Sony took WD the first day and BOW on day 3 and 4 to finish his championship (both 3 point wins). It was all very exciting.

CKC requires that you have 10 points to finish. They don't have majors, but you need at least two 2 point wins to finish. You get points by taking WD or WB (points are awarded for the number of girls or boys you beat. But if you take BOW, points are awarded for the combined number of boys and girls you beat – pretty different from here.

Jerry and I would not hesitate to do this again – it was great fun!

Buddy Recipes

What is your favorite recipe?

- 6 slices cooked bacon, crumbled
- 4 eggs, well beaten
- 1/8 cup bacon fat
- 1 cup water
- 1/2 cup non-fat dry milk powder
- 2 cup graham flour
- 2 cup wheat germ
- 1/2 cup cornmeal

Mix ingredients with a strong spoon; drop heaping tablespoonfuls onto a greased baking sheet. Bake in a 350 oven for 15 minutes. Turn off oven and leave cookies on baking sheet in the oven overnight to dry out. Yields about 4 dozen dog cookies.
